- We continue to make progress on a number of water quality restoration projects, including Danforth Creek, Cypress Creek / Culpepper Ranch, and Kitching Creek. We are also looking at projects in Rio and Manatee Creek and are pursuing funding for these efforts.
- We have been pursuing water quality grants to help fund some of these projects, and are currently in a "waiting period" to find out if we will successfully receive those grant funds.
- We have been working very hard on the FDEP effort on the St. Lucie Basin TMDL / Basin Management Action Plan, which essentially prescribes projects to be built that help improve water quality to achieve the TMDL targets. This effort has the potential to require tens of millions of dollars to build projects that will achieve the targets, so we are getting very involved on the technical assumptions that were made to set the stage for compliance (basically to ensure that we receive due credit for projects that we have already completed that improve water quality).
