- <u>Martin County:</u> Dianne Hughes reported that the Lake O. level is at 13'. Next water Ambassador Class is May 19. - <u>State and Federal Agencies and Issues:</u> Dr. Paul Gray: Lake O is losing its grasses. Lake O needs SB10. Right now it is too deep, too muddy, plants have no light when they are 2-3 feet under water

- <u>Indian Riverkeeper Update:</u> Marty Baum said there is not enough light in the river, too much turbidity. Marty had a "blast" at the River Kidz Beach Trash Art Event. The Surfriders have a "Ban the Bag" program starting soon. On Tuesday Marty and Dr. Gilmore are putting hydrophones in the St. Lucie River to determine the health of the lagoon by listening to the fish.
- <u>Local Issues & Estuary Water Quality:</u> Michelle Byriel of FOS reported that Katie Tiling will be conducting seagrass surveys of the St. Lucie River Estuary. They are needing research volunteers for oyster restoration on May 17, seagrass survey on May 24 and seagrass matting on May 30. The sea turtle nesting season is here and the night tours start May 30.
