<u>State Report</u>: Doug Gaston of Audubon spoke for Dr. Paul Gray. Lake O level needs to come down even more for sunlight to get to the bottom to improve ecosystem.

Representative from Sen Rubio reported that Sen. Rubio is requesting the \$200 million be put back into Federal budget for local agencies such as ACOE and SFWMD.

John Haddox spoke for Brian Mast about the "Local Water Protection Act" to study the point source of pollution and get more money for local governments.
