- <u>State and Federal Agencies and Issues:</u> Dr. Paul Gray of Audubon: Lake O is over 2.5' from this time last year. <u>Coalition Reports:</u> N/A
- Rivers Coalition Defense Fund Update: Charles Grande says 1) we need to pressure SFWMD to send as much water south as pOssible 20 PSL: their canals feed the North Fork of St. Lucie River, There are the same human markers in inland as with septic systems because of the bio-solids being spread on inland farms and the rain flushes the excrement into the north Fork.
- <u>Indian Riverkeeper Update:</u> Marty Baum said there is a movement to rename Ft. Pierce State inlet Park to Lace Vitanac State Park. Grant Gilmore and Marty put hydrophones into the Jensen Beach Causeway waters and there was NO fish noise. No trout spawning now, even though there have been noise there ever since they started monitoring it 1960.
