Opening Comments:

Eve Samples commented on the significant announcement made the day before by USACE re: LOSOM. At this critical moment for the SLR and Everglades, the 8 model runs had disappointingly HIGH volumes of average annual basin runoff coming to the SLR.

Eve asked is there was a shift in the USACE Philosophy?

Why not use the other model runs closer to original Plan CC?

There are questions on the recovery period of Lake O. When the Hoover Dike is completed will the Lake be kept higher? Will there be even more volumes released to SLR to trigger the recovery of the lake after being so high? The EAA makes out much better in these 8 models. This will be a much worse outcome than the original Plan CC.

Presentation:

<u>University of Miami Harmful Algal Bloom Study:</u>Addison Testoff, MPS and Kim Popendorf, Researcher. This DISPEL HAB Study is funded by FL Dept of Health. They explained their protocols and are looking for more participants.

LOSOM Update: US Army Corps of Engineers Team:

Tim Gysan responded to Eve's questions: The goals and philosophy of the USACE are still the same. Striving for flexibility and maximize the water flow to the South. There are a lot of variables: The Seminole Tribe, the protected entitlements, the flow to the West.

Charles Grande-The higher Lake Level is nothing but bad news to us. Who benefits from the increase in Lake Level? Is it for water supply to the EAA? We are very disappointed on these model runs chosen.
